The Greatest Topic!

- Mat 7:12 Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.
- Mat 18:32 Then his lord, after that he had called him, said unto him, O thou wicked servant, I forgave thee all that debt, because thou desiredst me:
- Mat 18:33 Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellowservant, even as I had pity on thee?
- Mat 22:36 Master, which is the great commandment in the law?
- Mat 22:37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.
- Mat 22:38 This is the first and great commandment.
- Mat 22:39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- Mat 22:40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.
- Mat 25:40 And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.
- Luk 6:46 And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?
- Luk 7:47 Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little.

Luk 10:29 But he, willing to justify himself, said unto Jesus, And who is my neighbour?

Luk 10:30 And Jesus answering said, A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead.

Luk 10:31 And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side.

Luk 10:32 And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side.

Luk 10:33 But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him,

Luk 10:34 And went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him.

Luk 10:35 And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee.

Luk 10:36 Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves?

Luk 10:37 And he said, He that shewed mercy on him. Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise.

Joh 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

- Joh 13:34 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. Joh 13:35 By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- Joh 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.
- Joh 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;
- Joh 14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.
- Joh 14:22 Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world?
- Joh 14:23 Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.
- Joh 14:24 He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.
- Joh 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.
- Joh 15:8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.
- Joh 15:9 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: **continue ye in my love.**
- Joh 5:10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.
- Joh 15:11 These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.

- Joh 15:12 This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.
- Joh 15:13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.
- Joh 15:14 Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.
- Joh 15:15 Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you.
- Joh 15:16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.
- Joh 15:17 These things I command you, that ye love one another.
- Rom 5:5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.
- Rom 5:6 For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
- Rom 5:7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die.
- Rom 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
- Rom 12:9 Let love be without <u>dissimulation</u>. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good.
- Rom 12:10 Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another;
- dissimulation=pretension; hypocrisy, assuming of a false or counterfeit appearance which conceals the real opinions or purpose

- Rom 13:8 Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.
- Rom 13:10 Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.
- Rom 14:13 Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother's way.
- 1Co 7:19 Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the commandments of God.
- 1Co 12:25 That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.
- 1Co 12:26 And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it

Love Chapter:

- 1Co 13:1 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.
- 1Co 13:2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.

- 1Co 13:3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.
- 1Co 13:4 Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,
- 1Co 13:5 Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;
- 1Co 13:6 Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;
- 1Co 13:7 Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.
- 1Co 13:8 Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away.

Charity=Love

- 2Co 5:14 For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead:
- 2Co 5:15 And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again.
- Gal 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.
- Gal 5:13 For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but **by love serve one another.**
- Gal 5:14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; **Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.**

- Gal 5:15 But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.
- Gal 5:22 But **the fruit of the Spirit is love,** joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,
- Gal 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- Gal 6:2 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.
- Gal 6:9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.
- Gal 6:10 As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.
- Eph 3:17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,
- Eph 3:18 May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;
- Eph 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.
- Eph 4:2 With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;
- Eph 4:3 Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

- Eph 4:15 But **speaking the truth in love**, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:
- Eph 4:32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.
- Eph 5:1 Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children;
- Eph 5:2 And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.
- Php 2:2 Fulfil ye my joy, that ye **be likeminded, having the same love**, being of one accord, of one mind.
- Php 2:3 Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.
- Php 2:4 Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.
- Php 2:5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:
- Col 3:12 Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;
- Col 3:13 Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye.
- Col 3:14 And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness.

- 1Th 1:3 Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and **labour of love**, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father;
- 1Th 3:12 And the Lord make you to increase and abound in love one toward another, and toward all men, even as we do toward you:
- 1Th 4:1 Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort you by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, so ye would abound more and more.
- 1Th 4:2 For ye know what commandments we gave you by the Lord Jesus.
- 1Th 4:3 For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication:
- 1Th 4:9 But as touching brotherly love ye need not that I write unto you: for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another.
- 2Ti 1:7 For **God hath not given us the spirit of fear**; but of power, and **of love**, and of a sound mind.
- Heb 13:1 Let brotherly love continue.
- Heb 13:2 Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.
- Heb 13:3 Remember them that are in bonds, as bound with them; and them which suffer adversity, as being yourselves also in the body.

Jas 2:8 If ye fulfil the <u>royal law</u> according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well:

- Jas 2:15 If a brother or sister be naked, and destitute of daily food, Jas 2:16 And one of you say unto them, Depart in peace, be ye warmed and filled; notwithstanding ye give them not those things which are needful to the body; what doth it profit?

 Jas 2:17 Even so **faith, if it hath not works, is dead,** being alone.
- 1Pe 1:22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto **unfeigned love of the brethren**, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:
- 1Pe 3:8 Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous:
- 1Pe 3:9 Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing.
- 1Pe 4:8 And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins.
 1Pe 4:9 Use hospitality one to another without grudging.
- 2Pe 1:7 And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to **brotherly** kindness charity.
- 2Pe 1:8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- 1Jn 2:3 And hereby we do know that we know him, **if we keep his commandments.**
- 1Jn 2:4 He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
- 1Jn 2:5 But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.
- 1Jn 2:6 He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.
- 1Jn 2:7 Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word which ye have heard from the beginning.
- 1Jn 2:8 Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth.
- 1Jn 2:9 He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now.
- 1Jn 2:10 He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him.
- 1Jn 2:11 But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes.
- 1Jn 3:11 For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.
- 1Jn 3:14 We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.

- 1Jn 3:15 Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him.
- 1Jn 3:16 Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.
- 1Jn 3:17 But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwelleth the love of God in him?
- 1Jn 3:18 My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth.
- 1Jn 3:22 And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.
- 1Jn_3:23 And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.
- 1Jn 3:24 And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.
- 1Jn 4:7 Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God.
- 1Jn 4:8 He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.
- 1Jn 4:10 <u>Herein is love</u>, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
- 1Jn 4:11 Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another.
- 1Jn 4:12 No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

- 1Jn 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.
- 1Jn 4:17 **Herein is our love made perfect,** that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.
- 1Jn 4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.
- 1Jn 4:19 We love him, because he first loved us.
- 1Jn 4:20 If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?
- 1Jn 4:21 And this commandment have we from him, **That he who loveth God love his brother also.**
- 1Jn 5:1 Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.
- 1Jn 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.
- 1Jn 5:3 For <u>this is the love of God</u>, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.
- 2Jn 1:4 I rejoiced greatly that I found of thy children walking in truth, as we have received a commandment from the Father.
- 2Jn 1:5 And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto thee, but that which we had from the beginning, that **we love one another.**
- 2Jn 1:6 And <u>this is love</u>, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.

Rev 22:14 Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.
